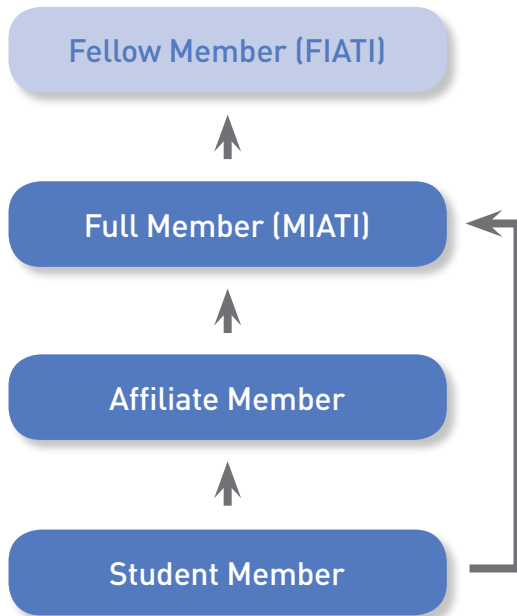


# Fellow Membership

Fellow membership is a new class of membership within Accounting Technicians Ireland and is awarded to our most experienced members.

As a Fellow member, you can use the professional letters FIATI to differentiate your senior experience and expertise within the accounting profession. You will also continue to receive our wide range of member services in addition to some new benefits which are exclusive to this group.

Fellow membership is open to anyone who has been a Full member of Accounting Technicians Ireland for 8 years and has at least 5 years experience of working in a senior position within their employment.



## How to become a Fellow Member?

Fellow membership is open to any Full members who meet the following requirements.

- **You have been a Full member of Accounting Technicians Ireland for at least 8 continuous years**

The 8 years continuous membership can be acquired at any time. For instance, if your membership ever lapsed, the 8 continuous years can have been accumulated either before or after that period.

- **You have at least 5 years experience working in a senior position within your employment**

The 5 years work experience to be considered must have been gained since you became a Full member. It can include roles where you had sole responsibility for certain tasks, or had supervisory or managerial duties, or perhaps worked on your own undertaking specialist project work. We do not specify the precise work experience necessary given the variety of accounting and finance roles.



- **You have a referee who can verify the most recent 3 years of your work experience**

Your referee can be your line manager, employer or a qualified accountant who has had direct knowledge of you and your work. They will need to verify the most recent 3 years of your work experience and the remaining 2 years experience can be detailed by you in a CV or letter. We are unable to count any experience if it occurred during a period of lapsed membership.

- **Your annual subscription is fully paid up at the time of application.**

## Industry recognition

## CPD training

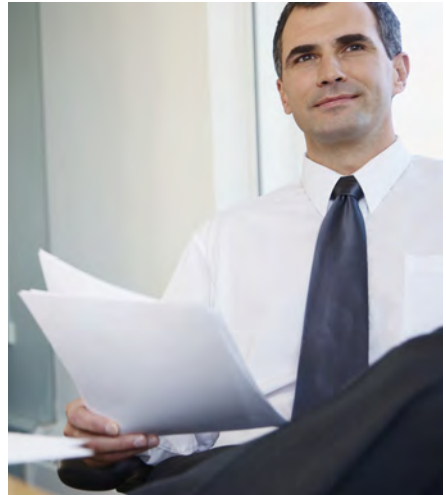
We run a series of leading edge CPD training courses to help you grow professionally and enhance your career. The cost of these courses is further discounted for Fellow members.

# How to apply



Please complete a Fellow Membership application form and return it with a one off application fee of €55 / £50. Your application will then be assessed and successful applicants will be invited to a graduation ceremony in May to receive a new certificate reflecting their new Fellow status.

After you become a Fellow member, the first Fellow membership subscription is payable in November and should be renewed annually. This is only €5 / £5 more than your current Full member subscription.

## Not yet ready to apply?

There is no time limit for you to apply for Fellow membership - you can submit an application whenever you're ready. We accept applications at the beginning of each year.

However, you can get a head start now by recording any senior experience you've already gained to help you achieve Fellow membership in the future. This may avoid any need to approach former employers at a later date.
