

Accounting Technicians Ireland Teaching Scheme YEAR 1:

Online or In person Classes: 26 x 1.5-hour sessions for each of the following modules:

FA = Financial Accounting; TXR = Taxation (ROI); BM = Business Management; BLR = Business Law (ROI).

These classes must be live and may be delivered online, in person or a combination of both depending on the partner college delivering this tuition.

Recorded Support Lectures (ATI): The recorded support lectures are delivered by ATI to bridge the gap between the 39 hours of online/in person classes and the total guided learning hours for each module. These lectures are pre-recorded and should be viewed alongside the appropriate class to build on previous learning. These support lectures will be available via your ATI Moodle account alongside the full schedule of availability.

MS Excel Skills (Basic) (ATI/IACT): 7 x 1.5-hour sessions. Alternate Mondays 6.00pm – 7.30pm and alternate Saturdays 11.30am – 1.00pm as per the teaching scheme. Students registered for the Financial Accounting module will be granted access to the MS Excel Skills (Basic) programme which is delivered online by ATI in partnership with the Irish Academy of Computer Training (IACT). Delivery includes free online classes/resources and an optional assessment for the MS Excel Skills (Basic) Certification. While we encourage students to avail themselves of the optional assessment and certificate, it is not a requirement for the terminal examinations.

Formative Assessments: Formative assessments will be facilitated by your module lecturer and it is recommended that they take place between weeks 6 and 13.

Mock Examinations: Mock exams are facilitated by ATI on the <u>Cirrus exam platform</u> during the month of June 2024. For further information re the mock exam process please refer queries to the Academy Programme Manager.

Examinations: Year 1 examinations will commence 6th August 2024 and will take place online via the Cirrus exam platform. Full details regarding exam delivery and requirements are provided within the 'Exam Centre' section in your ATI Moodle account.
